

6. The prize shall be bestowed by the panel of judges established by Fondazione Gramsci. The panel's judgment is not subject to dispute. The results shall be made known at [www.fondazionegramsci.org](http://www.fondazionegramsci.org) by 15 September 2022.
7. The amount shall be disbursed in a single payment during the public award ceremony to be held in the month of October in Latina. The winner's travel expenses and accommodations shall be borne by the Foundation. In addition to being in attendance, the winner will be asked to make a presentation on his/her research.

The annual prize is financed by the family of Alberto Cardosi. Alberto (1971 – 2014) attended Latina's "Ettore Majorana" scientific secondary school and was an active figure in the Pontine province's cultural debate. An impassioned reader of Gramsci, he deepened his knowledge of his writings during university studies at the Faculty of Political Sciences at "La Sapienza" University of Rome. His research efforts concerning Gramsci were contained in the book *Il popolo nel pensiero del giovane Gramsci*, drawn from his university dissertation and published by La Sapienza editrice in 2014, a few months before his death.
